

Elize Crafts

This pattern can be traced with Tinta white and gold ink, or any other colour to create a different effect.

Flower Bud Doily

Requirements:

- A3 size Pergamano paper
- Mapping pen and nib
- Gold Tinta ink (22T)
- White Tinta Pearl ink (1TP)
- Extra-large ball embossing tool
- Large ball embossing tool
- Small ball embossing tool
- Medium ball embossing tool
- Easy Grid fine mesh
- Quick and Easy 1-needle perforating tool
- Single needle perforating tool
- 2-needle perforating tool
- Embossing pad deluxe
- Perforating pad
- Kolinsky no.2 paintbrush
- Cutting mat
- Pergamano scissors (Stainless steel, Exclusive or Perga Cutter)
- White pencil
- Pergakit
- Toothpick
- Pins
- Piece of hardboard
- Sellotape

Legend:

S = areas to be stippled

TP = areas to be painted with Tinta-Pearl white ink prior to perforation

EGv = "v" grid pattern (every second row)

EGd = diagonal grid pattern (every second row)

EG = every hole grid pattern

EB = emboss from back

EF = emboss from front



Elize Crafts

Method:

- Join up the two halves of the patten in the centre
- Fix the parchment paper with two or three pieces of sellotape on top of the pattern
- Trace the entire design with mapping pen and Tinta Gold ink
- Paint the areas marked "TP" with Tinta Pearl white using the Kolinsky no.2 paintbrush
- Stipple the areas marked with "S" with the 1-needle tool. Colour the stippled areas with the white pencil both on the front and back.
- Use the completed design as a guide when embossing, using the applicable ball embossing tool. **Note:** The six sections in the centre are embossed both in front and back (refer to legend).
- Grid the relevant sections using the fine grid and quick-and-easy 1-needle perforating tool (refer to legend).
- Perforate the relevant sections with the 2-needle perforating tool as per completed design
- Cut out the above-mentioned perforated pieces with Pergamano scissors, using the cutting mat, to form the lace-work
- Mount the finished design onto a piece of hardboard using Pergakit.
- Frame, admire, and hang on a special spot against your wall.
